Dear Esteemed Colleague,

I am writing to cordially invite you to nominate your outstanding middle school students for the **2024 UofL Summer Middle School Wind Band Institute**. We will be offering a special ensemble experience for middle school students who can successfully perform up to *Grade 2* music. The camp will focus on performance instruction, comprehensive musicianship, playing techniques, and theory skills.

This year's Middle School Wind Band Institute will run from the afternoon of **Sunday, June 2, through the evening of Thursday, June 6, 2024.** We are delighted to have with us Guest Conductors Mr. Phil Thomas (Highland Hills Middle School, Retired Band Director), and Ms. Linda Pulley (Noe Middle School Band Director), as well as UofL faculty and students.

Note: Due to an HVAC renovation, the UofL School of Music will be closed through the summer. <u>The 2024</u> <u>Middle School Summer WBI will be hosted at Noe Middle School with the concert at duPont Manual High</u> <u>School.</u> Several activities will still be held on UofL's campus so that campers experience a slice of college life.

On check-in day, each student will complete a brief placement audition and a brief theory exam to determine the appropriate placement within the ensemble and the most appropriate theory section. A band camper's musical day begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m., when they are picked up and return home for the evening. Each day will include full ensemble rehearsals, master classes, theory instruction, and an hour break for lunch. The final day on June 6 will conclude with a free public performance at duPont Manual High School.

The complete cost of the camp is \$195 and must be received by **Friday**, **May 17**. **Early registration is \$170 and must be received by Friday**, **April 26**. Included in the camp fee is instruction, a meal plan, and a camp T-shirt. Payments are NON-REFUNDABLE. Please complete and return the nomination form as soon as possible, as sections will close when filled. **The deadline for nominations is Wednesday**, **April 3**. Nominations should be sent directly to Kaelah McMonigle at <u>ulbands@louisville.edu</u> or regular mail.
